

Planning and Advanced Reservation of Capacity Agreement (PARCA)

PARCA NOTICE – RESERVATION OF NTS EXIT CAPACITY FOR TILBURY MARSHES

UPDATE – 24th September 2019

Dear Industry Colleague,

In accordance with the Uniform Network Code, Section B, National Grid hereby publishes this notice to all interested industry parties.

On 28th November, 2017 National Grid issued a notice with respect to the receipt of a competent Planning & Advanced Reservation of Capacity Agreement (“PARCA”) application. The PARCA application was for National Transmission System (“NTS”) exit capacity of between 17,301,946kWh/d and 21,146,822kWh/d in London, Suffolk & the South East (Region 9 in the Gas Ten Year Statement¹). The indicative capacity Registration Date specified at the time was 1st December, 2020.

On 29th May, 2018 National Grid issued a notice (“Tilbury Marshes Power Station ExCS Informal Notice (including exit Substitution & Baseline Revision)”). The informal notice confirmed that the PARCA Phase 1 Works had been completed to meet a capacity requirement of 21,146,822kWh/d for a capacity Registration Date of 1st December, 2020.

We are issuing this notice to provide an update to the notice issued on 3rd July, 2018. Due to a requested change, NTS exit capacity has been reserved as follows;

From 1st December, 2022 (changed from 1st December, 2020)
