

Licence Change for new points

National Grid made a proposal to Ofgem to update our Licence to change the process for adding new points. The purpose is to **simplify and make quicker**, the process of adding new points which have no associated capacity baseline obligations.

Following statutory consultation, Ofgem published their decision for implementation with effect from 10th December 2019.


