

Planning and Advanced Reservation of Capacity (PARCA)

NOTICE: OPENING OF A PARCA EXIT WINDOW

6th December, 2017

Dear Industry Colleague,

In accordance with the Uniform Network Code, Section B, National Grid hereby publishes this notice to all interested industry parties that a PARCA Exit Window has been opened. The PARCA Exit Window provides an opportunity for those parties who are interested in applying for a PARCA to submit their applications during this time so that we can consider those applications alongside other potential projects.

The application received was as follows;

Project 1

The geographical area of the project is South Wales and West Midlands South (Region 4 in the Gas Ten Year Statement¹).

The amount of NTS exit capacity applied for is between 12,900,000kWh/d & 28,380,000kWh/d.

The indicative capacity reservation date is 27th May, 2018.

The indicative capacity registration date is 1st October, 2020.

The PARCA Exit Window will be opened for a maximum of 40 consecutive business days from 7th December 2017, closing on 6th February 2018. If no further PARCA Applications are received within 20 consecutive business days the window will be closed on 9th January 2018.
